Proceedings

The present complaint the issue between the parties qua the same apartment already stands settled by way of arbitration award dated 21.07.2020. The complainant herein has challenged the award by filling a petition bearing no. ARB-130-2020 for setting aside the award under section 34 of the arbitration and cancellation Act, 1996 and the same is pending adjudication before the district court Gurugram. The implementation of the award dated 21.07.2020 was stayed by the court vide order dated 09.10.2020.

The counsel of the respondent is stating that Hon'ble National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, New Delhi when faced with the identical situation passed the following order dated 21.09.2022 in the matter
