<u>ORDER</u>

Today, the case is fixed for awaiting report regarding handing over the possession to the decree holder after settlement of accounts.

2. Learned counsel for judgment debtor has informed that dispute between the parties also been settled and copy of settlement deed has been filed with the office which is yet to be received by this Forum. The factum of receipt of copy of the settlement deed has got confirmed.

However, none has appeared on behalf of the decree holder. Case called several times. It is already 04:00 PM. No further wait is justified. Hence, the present execution petition is **dismissed in default** for want of prosecution in view of the provisions of Order XXI Rule 105 of CPC, as this Forum while exercising the power under Section 40 of the RERA Act, 2016 read with Rule 27 of HRERA, Rules, 2017, is competent to exercise powers of a Civil Court, in the same manner as Civil Court is dealing with execution of a civil decree.
