RAJAN GUPTA, CHAIRMAN (ORAL):

There is delay of 432 days in filing the appeal. Application for condonation thereof has been moved. Notice in the said application was not issued. Respondents, however, put in appearance on their own.

Learned counsel for the appellant states that the matter has been settled between the parties. An amount of Rs.43,93,298/- by way of two demand drafts of Rs.21,96,649/- each have been remitted to the respondents.

The aforesaid contention is not controverted by Mr.
