### **ORDER**

Since, the decree holder has not provided the details of property of judgment debtor situated within territorial jurisdiction of the transferee Court, the compliance of provision of Section 46 of CPC is not compulsory in the case in hand. Consequently, let the file in original along with order sending decree execution to another Court and certificate of non-satisfaction of decree after keeping photocopies of the record.

This Forum does not deem it appropriate to give personal hearing to the decree holder to support his application under consideration, as he has shown his grievance and requirement in the application under consideration which is self explanatory.

On request of the decree holder, file is taken up today.

In consequence of order of transfer of execution petition on the request of decree holder, the present execution petition be treated as transfer to another Forum of competent jurisdiction. The Data Entry Operator concerned to update the status of the execution petition accordingly for the purpose of record and information of the parties.
