### **ORDER (PARNEET S SACHDEV - CHAIRMAN)**

Present suo-motu complaint was registered against the respondent promoter for changing the RERA bank account from the existing Yes Bank Account Number 1666300000115 to Kotak Mahindra Bank Account Number 3248471625 of a registered real estate project of a commercial colony on land measuring 4105.23 sq. mtrs. situated in Village Bhatola Sector-79, Faridabad, Haryana registered vide Registration No. 76 of 2017 dated 21.08.2017 valid upto 31.12.2027.

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2. A show cause notice dated 21.09.2023 was issued under Section-35 of the RERA Act, 2016 as to why penalty under Section-61 of the RERA Act, 2016 be not imposed for changing the RERA account and obtaining loan without the permission of the Authority. The respondent was also directed to submit detail of balance amount in old account of Yes Bank and the new account in Kotak Mahindra Bank duly supported by CA Certificate.
3. The matter was last considered by the Authority on 08.05.2024 wherein it was observed that since the respondent has changed its bank account without the permission of the Authority, it has violated the provisions of the Act and hence is liable for penalty under Section 61 of the Act. Therefore, respondent was burdened with a penalty of ₹3,00,000/- to be paid before the next date of hearing.
4. On 13.11.2024, Sh. Kamal Dahiya, learned counsel for the respondent sought time to file detailed reply in the matter.
5. On 15.01.2025, neither any reply was filed by the respondent nor penalty deposited. The Authority decided to adjourned the matter to 26.03.2025 granting last opportunity to the respondent to deposit the above said penalty failing which RERA rate of interest shall be imposed.
6. On the last date of hearing i.e., 26.03.2025, learned counsel Sh. Tarun Ranga, informed that he is appearing for the first time and has been instructed and authorised to appear and his memo of appearance has been filed in the registry of

the Authority. Learned counsel requested to adjourn the matter to some other suitable date in the interest of justice.

In view of above, Authority decided to adjourn the matter to 14.05.2025 and directed the Promoter to submit its reply at least one week before the next date of hearing. The Authority also directed the respondent to deposit the said penalty along with interest at the rate of SBI's highest marginal cost of lending rate (MCLR) + 2% as per Rule 15 of the RERA Rules, 2017 before the next date of hearing.





7. Vide reply dated 12.05.2025 filed in the Agenda Matter which is also listed for hearing today, the promoter has submitted that the change of bank accounts was neither intentional nor deliberate as the same was done each time to facilitate the interest of allottees and for the purpose of their convenience. The details of amount credited and amount withdrawn during quarters can be verified from the QPRs time to time and the promoter has always complied with the provisions of Section-4(2)(1)(d) of the RERA, Act,2016. The Promoter has requested to waive the said penalty and dispose of the matter.

8. In view of the above, the Authority observed that the reply filed by the Promoter is not satisfactory. The Authority grants one last opportunity to the Promoter to submit a detailed reply. The Authority also directs the respondent to deposit the said penalty of Rs. 3 Lacs along with interest at the rate of SBI's

highest marginal cost of lending rate (MCLR) + 2% as per Rule 15 of the RERA Rules, 2017 before the next date of hearing.

The Promoter is directed to submit its reply at least one week before the next date of hearing.
