ORDER (NADIM AKHTAR-MEMBER)

- 1. As per office record notice dated 06.06.2025 was delivered to the respondent on 09.06.2025.
- 2. Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, the Authority carefully examined the contents of the complaint filed by the complainant.
- 3. Upon perusal of the complaint, it has come to the notice of the Authority that the complaint is devoid of any relief clause or prayer specifying the precise relief(s) sought by the complainant from this Authority. It is a well-settled principle that for any quasi-judicial body or statutory Authority to adjudicate a matter, the complainant must clearly set out the relief(s) being claimed, so that the respondent may respond appropriately and the Authority may determine whether such reliefs fall within its jurisdiction and competence under the provisions of the Real Estate (Regulation and Development) Act, 2016.
- 4. In the absence of a clearly articulated relief clause, the complaint suffers from a fundamental defect and cannot be proceeded with on merits. The Authority cannot be expected to presume or infer the relief(s) that the complainant seeks, particularly in view of the binding nature of orders passed under the Act.

- Accordingly, the present complaint is dismissed, with liberty to the 5. complainant to file a fresh complaint after incorporating an appropriate relief clause, in accordance with the provisions of the Act and applicable Rules and Regulations.
- In view of the aforesaid observation, the present case is hereby dismissed and 6. accordingly stands disposed of.
