Heard on an application filed by JD with a prayer to recall warrants of detention issued against directors of JD and also to de-attach bank accounts of same.


Notice of application is accepted by learned counsel for DH Sh. Abhijeet Gupta. It is submitted by learned counsel for JD that her client is ready to pay decretal amount, though in instalments. A schedule of payment is annexed with the application. A cheque for a sum of Rs. 3,12,500/- is handed over to learned counsel for DH, which is accepted by him as part payment.

Bank accounts of JD i.e. A/C No. 02802320000042, A/C No. 5720350000172 and A/C No. 05720350000275, of HDFC Bank Limited were attached vide order dated 23.07.2024. Learned counsel has no objection if said bank accounts of JD are ordered to be de-attached. Considering same, request is allowed. Bank accounts of JD mentioned above are de-attached.

At the same time, learned counsel for DH has no objection if warrants of detention issued against directors of JD are suspended till next date i.e. 24.07.2025. Warrants of detention issued against directors of JD are thus suspended till next date. Copy of this order be sent to Bank Manager for information. Another copy be provided to JD to be served upon Bank Manager.
