

3. The Orders dated 12.03.2025 were again sent to the IRP (Mr. Manoj Kulsherestha) via Registered post on 21.05.2025 which was delivered on 24.05.2025 and via E-mail on 23.05.2025.
4. The orders dated 28.05.2025 were sent to the IRP (Mr. Manoj Kulsherestha) via Registered post on 20.08.2025 which was delivered on 25.08.2025 and via E-mail on 01.09.2025.
5. On 03.09.2025, Sh. Manoj Kulsherestha, IRP appeared and sought time to file written reply regarding the latest status of case. The request was accepted and the matter was adjourned to 03.12.2025.
6. On 03.12.2025, no one appeared on behalf of the respondent. However, perusal of the office records reveal that an affidavit has been submitted by the IRP on 09.09.2025 wherein it is stated that he is now the erstwhile Resolution Professional and therefore no longer holds any official position in the respondent company. Furthermore, in compliance of the orders of the NCLT, he has handed over the charge of the company to the newly appointed management i.e. *Srijan Infra LLP* the details of which are as follows:

7. The Authority directed the office to send a copy of this Order to the above-mentioned address. The firm, *Srijan Infra LLP*, is further directed to appear before the Authority on the next date of hearing through its authorized representative or legal counsel, to apprise the Authority of the present status of the matter.
8. On 25.02.2026, Sh. Gaurav Aggrawal informed that the license of the project is not valid as on date. As soon as the renewal of license is obtained, the registration application of the project shall be submitted. The Authority directed that resolution plan of the project be submitted

along with the information regarding the creation of third-party rights in the project.

The office is also directed to send a copy of this order at the email address of Sh. Gaurav Agarwal.

9. In compliance with the directions issued by this Authority, the order dated 25.02.2026 was duly served upon Sh. Gaurav Agarwal, via mail on 02.04.2026.
10. Today, Sh. Gaurav Agarwal, the authorized representative for the respondent, appeared before the Authority. He submitted that the requisite license has been renewed upto 09.06.2026 in favour of Srijan Infra LLP. Consequently, an application for registration has been preferred via Temporary ID No. 2022 of 2026 on 05.05.2026.
11. In view of the submissions made by the authorized representative and the subsequent filing of the registration application, the Authority deems it fit to dispose of the present matter. However, it is clarified that the disposal of these proceedings shall not preclude the office from levying statutory penalties, if any, during the scrutiny and examination of the said registration application.
12. **Disposed of.** File be consigned to record room after uploading of these orders.
