During the course of proceedings, it has been observed that while scrutinizing the complaint and annexures, the complaint was rejected on the ground that the same was addressed to the Adjudicating Officer instead of HARERA authority and three copies of the complaint were returned to the complainant by retaining a copy for office record. In spite of this, notices for appearances to the parties were also issued and the matter has been listed today for final hearing which is contrary to the guidelines issued by the authority from time to time and this negligence has created embarrassment for the authority. Accordingly, it is directed that show cause notices be issued to the delinquent officials on account of negligence on their part.

It is further directed that in case of such type of occurrences in future strict action shall be taken against the delinquent officials.

In view of the above position, this complaint does not lie before the authority.

Since the complainant has already filed a fresh complaint which is addressed to the authority, it is directed that the same may be listed for final hearing on completion of pleadings.
