Report on the Audit of the Standalone Financial Statement

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying standalone financial statement of Galaxy Realcon Private Limited ("the Company"), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at March 31,2021, the statement of Profit and Loss and the statement of Cash Flows for the year then ended and notes to the financial statement including a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.
