Standard for permits for the grant of permission for disposal of mineral extracted incidental to developmental activities


Whereas. M/s. Tula Realtor Pvt. Ltd. Through Manish Bhupinder Kumar Bakshi R/o G-14, Ground Floor, Jangpura Extension, New Delhi, has applied for the grant of a short term permit under rule 27 to 35 of the Haryana Minor Mineral Concession, Stocking & Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of illegal Mining Rules 2012, for disposal of 11185 M.T. of Ordinary Clay excavated / removed from Site STP/WTP Village Pataudi and Rampur Sector 1 Gurugram, digging of foundation / basement the applicant has paid the due royalty and application fees in advance Rs. 49,500/- Vide GRN No. 0116644999 dt. 14.05.2024 & Security amount is Rs. 24,500/- vide GRN No. 0116645835 dt. 14.05.2024 (50% of the amount of royalty).

- 1 The permission is hereby granted for disposal of 11185 MT mineral Ordinary Clay excavated /removed from the aforesaid area subject to the conditions that the permit holder will abide by the safety guards for such excavation or removal.
- 2 The permit holder shall transport/disposal off the ordinary clay/ earth from the site of the excavation, only by issuing a Mineral Transit Pass.
- 3 The amount of security deposit shall entail no interest. The security amount shall be refunded within a period of three months in case the same is not forfeited or required to be detained for any other purpose under this permit.
- 4 Any sum due from the permit holder shall be recovered from him as an arrear of land Revenue.

The permission shall be valid up to 30.06.2024.
