**Standard for permits for the grant of permission for disposal of mineral extracted incidental to developmental activities**


Whereas M/s. Peerage Buildwell Pvt. Ltd. Through Mr. Abhishek Gupta R/o 501, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Time Tower, MG Road, Gurugram, has applied for the grant of a short term permit under rule 27 to 35 of the Haryana Minor Mineral Concession, Stocking & Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of illegal Mining Rules 2012, for disposal of 174190 M.T. of Ordinary Clay excavated / removed from Site Village Badha & Hayatpur, Sector - 89 Gurugram, digging of foundation / basement the applicant has paid the due royalty and application fees in advance Rs. 7,63,500/- vide DD. No. 204223, Dt. 21.09.2023. GRN No. 0107490068 DT. 22.09.2023 & Security amount is Rs. 3,81,500/- Vide DD. No. 204224. Dt. 21.09.2023. GRN No. 0107490179 Dt. 22.09.2023 (50% of the amount of royalty).

- 1 The permission is hereby granted for disposal of 174190 MT mineral Ordinary Clay excavated /removed from the aforesaid area subject to the conditions that the permit holder will abide by the safety guards for such excavation or removal.
- 2 The permit holder shall transport/disposal off the ordinary clay/ earth from the site of the excavation, only by issuing a Mineral Transit Pass.
- 3 The amount of security deposit shall entail no interest. The security amount shall be refunded within a period of three months in case the same is not forfeited or required to be detained for any other purpose under this permit.
- 4 Any sum due from the permit holder shall be recovered from him as an arrear of land Revenue.

The permission shall be valid up to 21.09.2024.
