**Standard for permits for the grant of permission for disposal of mineral extracted incidental to developmental activities**

Whereas **M/s. Emmar India Ltd. Through Mr. Kul Bhushan R/o 306 -308 Square One C-2 District Centre, Saket New Delhi**, has applied for the grant of a short term permit under rule 27 to 35 of the Haryana Minor Mineral Concession, Stocking & Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of illegal Mining Rules 2012, for disposal of **60,107 M.T. of Ordinary Clay** excavated / removed from **Stilt and MEP Services Site ( License No. 10 of 2009, 113 of 2011, 117 of 2022) Group Hosingh Colony Village Nangliumarpur Tehsil Badshhpur Sector 62 Gurugram** digging of foundation / basement the applicant has paid the due royalty and application fees inadvance **Rs. 2,63,766/- Vide GRN No. 0119947884 dt. 08.08.2024 & Security amount is Rs. 1,31,633/- vide GRN No. 0119948770 dt. 08.08.2024** (50% of the amount of royalty).

- 1 The permission is hereby granted for disposal of **60,107 MT mineral Ordinary Clay** excavated /removed from the aforesaid area subject to the conditions that the permit holder will abide by the safety guards for such excavation or removal.
- 2 The permit holder shall transport/disposal off the ordinary clay/ earth from the site of the excavation, only by issuing a Mineral Transit Pass.
- 3 The amount of security deposit shall entail no interest. The security amount shall be refunded within a period of three months in case the same is not forfeited or required to be detained for any other purpose under this permit.
- 4 Any sum due from the permit holder shall be recovered from him as an arrear of land Revenue.

The permission shall be valid up to **13.04.2025**.
